Rebuilding Together Houston repairs homes at no cost for low-income elderly, military veterans, and people with disabilities. Through the work of volunteers and the generosity of donors, we enhance the quality of life for homeowners in need and strengthen the Houston community.

WHAT WE DO



VOLUNTEER HOME REPAIR

Volunteers seal the envelope of the home: scraping, caulking, and painting exterior walls; repairing siding and fascia; and securing doors and windows. Our **Students in Service** program allows scouts, high school and college students to develop hands-on construction and home repair skills under adult leadership.



SAFE AND SOUND SERVICES

Pairs of volunteers install grab bars, steps and handrails, smoke and CO detectors, fire extinguishers, safety aids and air filtration systems to prevent falls, fires, and improve air quality inside homes.



RAMP ANGELS

Skilled teams of volunteers construct durable wheelchair ramps improving homeowner mobility and independence.



CRITICAL SYSTEMS REPAIR

Professional contractors complete repairs to structural, electrical and plumbing systems.



ROOF RESTORATION

Professional contractors replace damaged or leaking roofs.

OUR HARVEY RESPONSE

As we have been throughout our history, RTH is here for *the long haul* to support these vulnerable populations.



HOME AFTER HARVEY

To rebuild after Harvey, teams of volunteers will replace dry wall and insulation, and install basic kitchen and bathroom fixtures. Repairs such as electrical, plumbing, roofing and leveling will be completed by contractors.

Qualified Harvey-impacted homes will be assessed and assigned other Rebuilding Together Houston programs as needed.
