Overview

- Virtual Learning centers will serve as a support for parents who need a safe place for their HISD student to access their virtual learning.
- Centers will be available to targeted HISD students in PK-7th grade.
- Older students may be able to volunteer in centers.
- Programming will be facilitated by church staff and volunteers with support from the HISD academic departments, Wraparound services and Nutrition services and is free of charge

HISD Support

- Site Visits: audit available space and brainstorm appropriate usage, review available wifi and technology, outdoor/recreational space, meal space
- Registration: school staff will identify, recruit and sign up students
- Academic Schedule: HISD will provide timing of academic course work
- PPE: HISD will provide masks, and other supplies
- Staff support: Staff will be assigned to report to locations
- Meals: HISD will provide breakfast, lunch and snack

Safety Provisions

- All volunteers will be required to complete online volunteer orientation and be VIPS approved
- HISD staff will be assigned to centers
- Students should be signed in and out
- Parents will sign a permission form including drop off/pick up instructions
- All sites will maintain social distancing, proper ratios, frequent hand washing and mask usage
- Volunteers will utilize the Rule of three: at no time will a volunteer be alone with a student.
