



Schools are looking for RELATIONSHIPS!



Because of COVID:




•28% of respondents felt hopeless


Material Poverty




•16% of respondents did not have device needed for schoolwork

Education — because of COVID




•45% of respondents worry their student(s) will not be ready for the new school year




Education beyond high school is needed

















- Acknowledging and fighting against racial injustices and inequalities




DEVELOPMENT:

Legal Guidelines

What to do in your partnership:

- Serve as any other community partner would
 - Mentor
 - Tutor
 - Support Teachers

What to do in your partnership:

- Advertise church-sponsored activities
- Offer optional faith-based programs
 outside of school hours

What not to do in your partnership:

- Proselytize or evangelize
- Initiate conversations on religion
- Directly invite children, families, or staff to church






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
