




13% visit doctor when sick

30% students often feel sad, lonely, anxious






20% students missed school due to mental health












unable to pay mortgage sometimes



- Being an advocate of justice




DEVELOPMENT:

 - Train students on marketable skills
 - Employ community members

Legal Guidelines

What to do in your partnership:

- Serve as any other community partner would
 - Presence
 - Prayer
 - Participation
 - Promotion

What to do in your partnership:

- Advertise church-sponsored activities
- Offer optional faith-based programs
 outside of school hours

What not to do in your partnership:

- Proselytize or evangelize
- Initiate conversations on religion
- Directly invite children, families, or staff to church

- Fill in for Grandparents Day



Teachers & Staff: High Level Commitment

- Weekly prayer support
- Monthly teacher treats
- "Adopt a Classroom"
- Volunteer as a Teacher's Assistant
- Weekly/monthly word of encouragement



Teachers & Staff: Occasional Commitment

- Substitute teach
- Volunteer for a field trip / special event


Education beyond high school is needed




